SOIL TYPE Chalky clay slopes and plateaux.

GRAPE VARIETIES 100% Merlot
Average age of vines: 35 years.

WINEMAKING TECHNIQUES Manual picking when grapes are fully ripe. Total destemming. Vatting lasts about three weeks depending on vintage. Temperatures are monitored. Consultant œnologist: Michel ROLLAND and Christian VEYRY.

ELABORATION Wine is aged in oak casks.

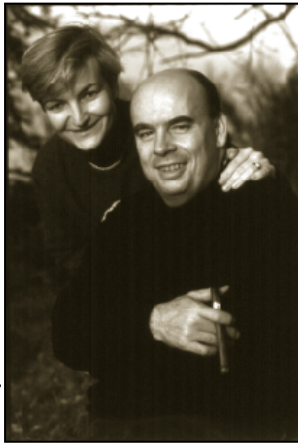
